

REQUIREMENTS FOR PROFESSIONAL LICENSING IN GHANA

- 1. Transcript of training. (To be forwarded to the Council directly).
- 2. 3 Passport size photographs. (With a white shirt).
- 3. Copy of Birth Certificate.
- 4. Photocopies of Professional Certificates (original copy to be presented for inspection).
- 5. Marriage Certificate where applicable.
- 6. 2 Testimonials from place of work where you have practiced for at least one year.
- 7. Copy of last appointment letter for practice.
- 8. Verification of the registration to be received from original Council / Board. (To be forwarded to the Council directly).
- 9. Examination Fee.
- 10. Practical Orientation in a Teaching or Regional hospital for ninety days.
- 11. Registration forms to be completed and Licensing fee to be paid.

The above are needed before processing of documents for the Examination and Registration in Ghana begins.

NB: Applicants from non-English Speaking countries must produce a certificate of Proficiency in English language from an accredited language institution.

Documents which are in languages other than **English** should be translated into English with a copy of the document in the original language attached to it.
